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RISKWORLD 2024 Keynote Peter Diamandis

RISKWORLD opening keynote “The Meta-Trends for the Decade Ahead: The Future Is Faster Than You Think,” will be delivered by Peter Diamandis, an entrepreneur and self-described “data-driven optimist.” Diamandis is the co-author of *Abundance*, a New York Times bestseller, and is the founder and executive chairman of the XPrize Foundation, which leads the world in designing and operating large-scale incentive competitions.

Diamandis joined RIMS to discuss how emerging technologies will impact today’s biggest industries and the way we care for our planet.

RIMS: Peter, why are you so excited to kick off RISKWORLD 2024?

Peter Diamandis: I’m excited because the entire risk profession is about to be transformed through exponential technologies. The impact of computation sensors, networks, AI, robotics, AR, VR, and blockchain will change how we understand, measure, and respond to risk. So, I want people to understand this and get excited about the new business models that will come out of this, as well.

RIMS: How would you describe your delivery or presentation style?

PD: I’m bouncing around the stage for sure. It will be a high-energy keynote and to the extent that I can, I’ll make it as interactive as possible.

RIMS: What concepts will you explore with the RISKWORLD audience?

PD: I’ll be talking about the data that shows how the world has been getting better on an extraordinary pace over the last century. It’s not happening because of better politicians or humans getting smarter, it’s a result of these exponential technologies transforming every aspect of our lives.

We’ll talk about the meta trends and how technology is transforming energy, communications, and even our lifespans. We’ll talk about artificial intelligence, which is the major conversation that should be happening in your boardroom, in your executive suite, and at your family’s dinner table. AI is going to change every aspect of our lives—not in a decade or two decades—but in the next two-to-five years.

This will impact business models. I think risk is one of the crucial components of these models, because it can be data-driven in

such extraordinary ways, given our ability to really harness the information from a trillion-sensor economy. AI will help us crunch that data to understand not how to offset and pay after a disaster occurs or after someone dies or something burns down but to prevent that in the first place.

RIMS: What do you love about risk management and working with risk professionals?

PD: I love working with professionals who want to transform their industry. My goal at RISKWORLD is to show the audience how the tools becoming available are enabling you to reinvent what you’re doing now.

For me, the ability of entrepreneurs and companies to take risks is directly proportional to the amount of advancement we can make in society. If you’re stuck not taking risks, you’re moving backward, or you’ve gone sublinear. All the things I’ve ever done in my life—and the 27 companies I’ve started—stem from a willingness to take risks.

Everyone in the audience will understand how they provide a buttressing or support mechanism which allows enterprises to go bigger and bolder than ever before. I believe this is the means by which we can make the world a better place. If I can help people see what’s possible and get excited about how they support taking risks, that’s critical.

RIMS: What is your risk philosophy?

PD: I like to say that the day before something is truly a breakthrough, it’s a crazy idea. And taking crazy ideas forward requires taking risks.

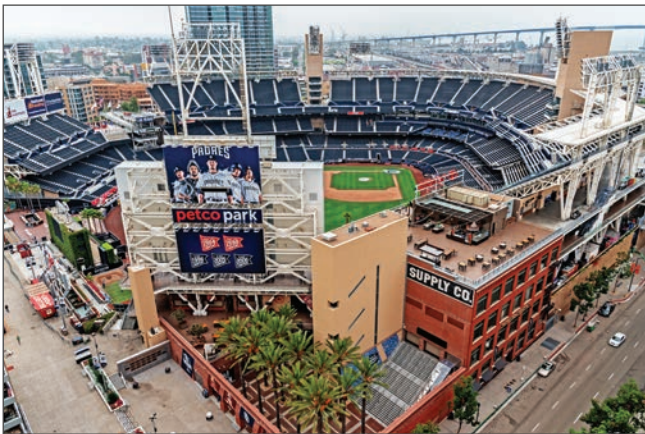

RIMS Advocates for You: 2024 Legislative Priorities and Related RISKWORLD Events

The evolution and unpredictability of risks have significantly impacted risk professionals’ ability to keep businesses operational and resilient. Adding to that challenge is a constantly changing legislative landscape that, too frequently, lags behind today’s biggest risks and lacks input from risk leaders.

Year after year, the volunteers who serve on the RIMS Public Policy Committee take action to fix that. The Committee is charged with identifying key legislation that impacts the risk and insurance community and seeking out opportunities to educate lawmakers and congressional leaders to ensure risk professionals’ concerns and perspectives are considered.

RIMS Public Policy Committee has identified the following as legislative priorities for 2024:

Data Privacy & Protection: As technology continues to evolve and organizations become more dependent on digital communication and online commerce, RIMS is focused on helping to define a federal framework for protecting privacy and data systems. This effort aims to address a patchwork of state laws that often cause confusion and lessen efficiency, especially for businesses operating in multiple jurisdictions.

National Flood Insurance Program Reauthorization: The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) has been reauthorized over 30 times by Congress through a series of short-term reauthorizations. Beyond supporting a long-term NFIP extension, RIMS advocates for flood mapping updates, blanket policies to eliminate the current frictional costs of purchasing separate NFIP policies for each property owned, as well as addressing roadblocks that discourage private insurance companies from entering the flood insurance market.

Freedom to Invest in Tomorrow’s Workforce Act (S. 722 / H.R. 1477): RIMS and many other associations are supporting this bipartisan legislation that would expand qualified expenses under 529 savings plans to include post-secondary training and credentialing, such as licenses and professional certifications like the RIMS-CRMP.

Strengthening RISK PAC: RIMS Political Action Committee (RISK PAC) is the only national political action committee that represents risk managers nationwide before Congress. RIMS Public Policy Committee and the RISK PAC Trustees will jointly develop new opportunities to educate congressional candidates and lawmakers about the practice of risk management, share the risk community’s concerns and perspectives, and provide financial support to

congressional campaigns that share RIMS views or who are in a position to influence policy.

At RISKWORLD, join RIMS Public Policy Committee leaders Polly James, senior director of risk management at Feld Entertainment, and Lynn Haley Pilarski, counsel, risk management and insurance at General Motors, as they dive deep into this year’s legislative priorities and advocacy initiatives.
